

RIGHT-WING POPULISM AND GENDER

 Observation: »Obsession with Gender« in the discourse of rightwing populist complex (Dietze/Roth 2020)

Gender ideologies: always important for right-wing, <u>but:</u> »only recently has a gender-based strategy moved to the forefront [...] of right-wing populist actors.« (Sauer 2017: 1, translation and emphasis JR)

»Right-wing Populist Complex« (to grasp complexity and multiple actors)








HAVANA TIMES – Brazil's president-elect Jair Bolsonaro (known for his likeness in expressing himeself with US President Trump) has stressed the difference between being a man or a woman, criticizing what he understands as "gender ideology" as a denial of Christian values.

Gender ideology says: "nobody is born man or woman, that it is a social construct," Bolsonaro said on Monday at the inauguration of a military police school, which was named after his father, in Duque de Caxias in Rio de Janeiro state, reported dpa news.

Pattern I: Gender as Affective Bridge in Mass Media

- Protection of traditional family and gender roles
- »Gender« as existential threat to the family and the (reproduction of) the nation
- Demonization of feminists, LGBTQI* activists, »gender ideology«
- »Reverse Anti-Colonialism« (Pope)
- Dynamic paradoxes (ethno-sexism, sexual exceptionalism, femonationalism, homonationalism)

>>> no mere »backlash«, more complex

(gender as meta language, arena, »symbolic glue«, »affective bridge«)




